Important information

- 1. Those files or procedures in which the interested party ceases to be active for more than SIX MONTHS will be filed, as long as the administrative body has exhausted the activity that corresponds to it and has NOTIFIED it.
2. To enter your application, you must comply with ALL the established requirements without exception.
3. It is the power of the Sub-direction of Immigration of the Guatemalan Institute of Migration to grant or deny the requested visas, therefore it is not obliged to grant the requested migratory status.
4. Visas approved to foreign persons do not imply their unconditional admission to the territory of the Republic of Guatemala. Likewise, the Guatemalan visa will only be issued in a valid and current passport or travel document. The passport must have at least a six-month validity.
5. All information on this form is subject to verification by the Guatemalan Immigration Institute.

(Articles 23 and 26 of National Migration Authority Agreement No. 9-2019, "Regulations for the Registration of Ordinary Migratory Status of the Guatemalan Migration Institute")

REQUIREMENTS

Present file in GREY color folder, duly numbered for admission without erasures or alterations.

1. Valid and current passport in original and copy; when not presenting a passport, a legalized copy must be attached, with an apostille or in accordance with the Law of the Judiciary, as the case may be.
2. Certification of validity and effect of the passport issued by the Embassy or Consulate of your country accredited in Guatemala. If Guatemala does not have diplomatic relations with the country of origin, present original and recent birth certificate with an apostille or in accordance with the Judicial Body Act, as the case may be.
3. Original Criminal and Police certificates from the country where you have legally resided for the last five years on a continuous basis, issued six months prior, with an apostille or in accordance with the provisions of the Judicial Body Act, as the case may be. If the country does not issue any of the above-mentioned certificates, it must present a refusal to do so.
4. Transport ticket, which must be round trip or Guatemalan guarantor presenting for the effect notarial act of constitution of Guatemalan guarantor under affidavit and updated record of registration of Guatemalan guarantor.
5. Proof of payment.

If the applicant is a minor or a person declared to be in a state of interdiction, in addition to the above, the following requirements must be attached to the application:

- a) Certificate of birth with an apostille or in accordance with the provisions of the Judicial Body Act, as appropriate. In the case of those declared in a state of interdiction, attach the documents stating such state.
- b) Complete and legalized copy of the passports of the parents in exercise of parental authority or legal representation.
- c) If the minor is travelling alone or accompanied by a third person, he or she must present written authorization signed by both parents or by the person exercising legal representation, as appropriate.

If the foreign national is required by a private institution, the following requirements must also be attached:

<p>For commercial entities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Certificate, signed and sealed by the owner or the legal representative of the entity in which the activity will be carried out, stating the term, amount that will be accrued and the activity that will be carried out in the country; 2. Certificate of registration of the individual company or corporation hiring the foreign national at the Mercantile Registry. 3. Legalized copy of the Company Trade Patent and the Company Trade Patent hiring the foreign national. 	<p>For sports entities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Certificate signed and sealed by the legal representative of the entity in which the activity will be carried out, indicating the term, amount to be accrued and activity to be carried out in the country. 2. Degrees, diplomas, recognitions or documents accrediting the status of an Athlete, with an apostille or in accordance with Judicial Body Act, as appropriate. 3. Legalized copy of the point of the assembly minutes, where the participation of the athlete is expressly authorized on a temporary basis.
<p>For cultural entities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Certificate signed and sealed by the legal representative of the entity where the activity will be carried out, stating the term, amount to be earned and activity to be carried out in the country. 2. Proof that the entity is affiliated to an institution of a cultural nature, endorsed by the Ministry of Culture and Sports. 	<p>For religious entities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Signed and sealed certificate, issued by the highest authority of the Catholic Church where the activity will take place, stating the period and activity that will take place in the country. 2. Legalized copy of the Personal Identification Document of the person representing the authorizing church. 3. For non-Catholic churches, church bylaws in legalized copy and legalized copy of the appointment of the Legal Representative.

OBSERVATIONS:

1. If documents are presented where the foreigner is known by several names, you must attach a Public Deed of Identification of Person. (Art. 4 Civil Code)
2. **The Guatemalan Guarantor Constitution Notarial Act shall contain: (*Individual Person*)** Tax Identification Number, Address of residence and work, Telephone number of residence and work; (*Legal Person and International Institutions*), Tax Identification Number, Fiscal and Commercial address according to the head office and telephone number. In both cases, the Guatemalan guarantor must expressly state "THAT IT IS **RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL THE EXPENSES OF STANDING AND THOSE OF UP TO AN EVENT REPATRIATION; ALSO, THAT IT AGAINST THE OBLIGATION TO INDICATE THE DATE OF DEPARTURE OF THE FOREIGNER OR CHANGE OF MIGRATION STATUS**".
3. **Economic capacity:** the foreigner must prove sufficient economic capacity to cover the costs of stay and return or prove it by means of the constitution of a Guatemalan Guarantor. This provision also applies to minors and their parents or legal representatives.
4. **In the case of minors,** the authorization for the minor to travel alone or accompanied by only one parent or third party must indicate the full name and passport number of the person with whom the minor will be travelling, if applicable.
5. A copy of the passport must be legalized by a Guatemalan notary. In case it is certified abroad, it will be subject to the provisions for documents coming from abroad.
6. In case it is for tourism activities, you must document hotel reservations, tourist packages, internal transfer tickets, etc.
7. In addition to the photo attached on the front of this document, you must submit another photo for the purpose of issuing the requested visa.
